ISE Cowl





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Size

Width 20 cm / 8", Height 42 cm / $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " (measured at highest point)

Material

Approx. 70 g ITO Sensai scraps (60% Mohair, 40% Silk; 20 g / 262 yds) in different colors Worked with 5 strands held tog. Combine colors as you like.

Needles

8 mm / US 11/L crochet hook

Gauge

10 sc x 12 rows = 10 cm / 4" over pattern using 8 mm / US 11 hook

Note

Cowl is worked flat in rows and sewn tog. The collar is crochet in rnds on the diagonal side.

Cowl

Ch 27.

Row 1-18: 27 sc, ch 1

Row 19: dec 1 at end of row

Row 20: dec 1 at beg of row

Row 21: dec 1 at end of row

Row 22: sc, ch 1

Rep row 19-22 3 more times (15 sc)

Row 35: dec 1 at end of row

Row 36: dec 1 at beg of row (13 sc)

Row 37: inc 1 at end of row

Row 38: inc 1 at beg of row (15 sc)

Row 39: 15 sc, ch 1

Row 40: inc 1 at beg of row

Row 41: inc 1 at end of row

Row 42: inc 1 at beg of row (18 sc)

Rep row 39-42 3 more times (27 sc)

Row 55-72: 27 sc, ch 1

Don't cut yarn!

Fold cowl in half and crochet tog short straight edges (that's the part before/after the decs/incs) with working yarn. Crochet collar in rnds on diagonal sides as follows: *1 sl st, ch 1, sc in every st until end of rnd (36 sc)*
Work 15 rnds.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.
